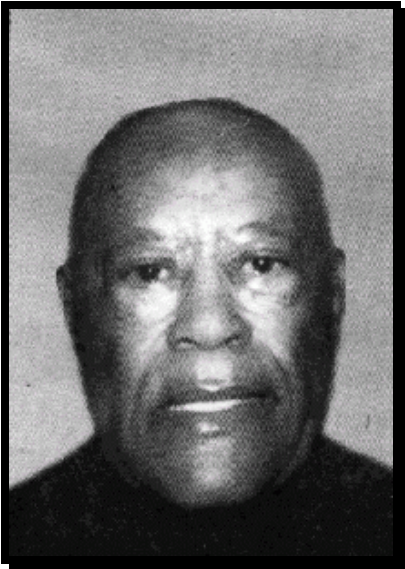

Sadrud-Din Hassan was
born Robert Foreman on

February 23, 1923 in Carrolton, Mississippi to the late Arthur Foreman and Annie Belle Davis Foreman.

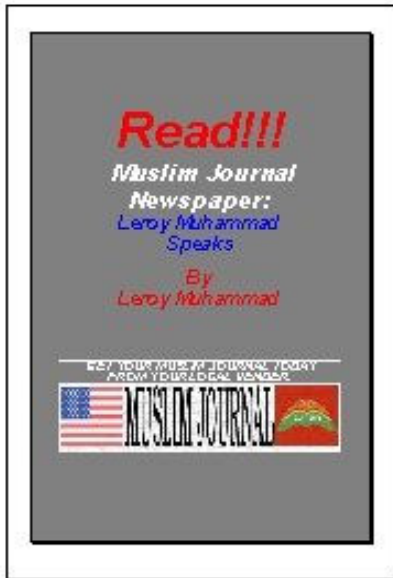
He received his education in Mississippi. He was honorably discharged from the US Navy in 1945. He was formerly employed at US Steel as a welder.

He converted to Al-Islam under the Honorable Elijah Muhammad and joined the Nation of Islam sometime in '50s or' 60s. Brother Hassan, as he was called by his Muslim brothers and sisters and many others, was dedicated to the *Mission of Al-Islam in America* for many years. After the Honorable Elijah Muhammad passed in 1975, Brother Hassan continued to follow the Honorable Elijah Muhammad's son Wallace. Brother Hassan was a soldier and a warrior for the cause of Al-Islam to the end and a role model and an inspiration for those that he came in contact with. He touched the lives of many while on his campaigns for truth and getting the word to the people as he called it. Brother Hassan fought bravely in the war of truth against falsehood with the

words of truth. His weapon of choice was the Muslim Journal and he could be seen on any given day with that paper inviting people to accept truth in their lives.

Brother Hassan returned to Allah (G-d) at the age of 84 on Wednesday, December 19, 2007 at 4:45 P.M. He was preceded in death by his parents, Arthur Forman and Annie Belle Davis Foreman; brothers, Phillip Foreman and Arthur L. Foreman; and sister, Anna Mae Jones.
